Epilepsy Master Class – Sydney – 7th August 2010



Dear colleague

The 4th ESA Epilepsy Master Class will be held in Sydney (venue TBA) on August 7th 2010, with special guest moderator Prof Ley Sander from the UK, who is an internationally renowned epileptologist with wide expertise including therapeutics, epidemiology and outcome of epilepsy.

This one-day, case-based course will highlight common and sometimes difficult problems in the management of adolescent and adult patients with epilepsy. Participants will discuss each case in small groups under the leadership of an epileptologist, followed by a short didactic summary by the presenter and comment from Prof Sander. The discussion of treatment strategies will be based on evidence from recent studies, complemented by the opinions of experienced epileptologists. The Master Class will thus be a mixture of evidence-based practice and clinical wisdom.

The Master Class is directed at neurology trainees but practising neurologists and epileptologists might well find the discussions instructive.

The ESA is grateful for the generous sponsorship provided once again by UCB. UCB will subsidise the cost of registration and provide air travel and Friday night accommodation for interstate delegates.
