Locum Consultant Neurologist

NHS Highland wishes to appoint a Locum Consultant Neurologist to assist in providing a modern service run to national quality criteria for the population of the Highlands. The post is for six to twelve months initially pending a substantive appointment. The Neurology service for NHS Highland is currently provided by a consultant neurologist and supported by a visiting service from the NHS Grampian neurology team. The post is based at Raigmore Hospital, Inverness, but applicants may be required to undertake work at other hospitals within NHS Highland. Applicants must be on the General Medical Council Specialist Register and in possession of or within 6 months of obtaining CCT in Neurology at the time of the interview.

Inverness is the Capital of the Highlands and enjoys a lifestyle and environment only dreamt of in other parts of the country offering a range of leisure and sporting opportunities, good quality affordable housing and excellent schools. Raigmore Hospital is a modern well-equipped district general hospital with 618 beds, which serves a catchment area of almost 10,000 square miles covering the entire Scottish Highlands, and a catchment population of 220,000 people (320,000 for tertiary care). The Department of Medicine comprises 211 beds including a critical care complex, a 22 bedded stroke unit and 8 beds for young adult rehabilitation.
