We run two national referral services - Epilepsy Video Monitoring and Epilepsy Surgery Program, and Deep Brain Stimulation - and a 24/7 multi-region stroke endovascular clot retrieval service.

Our location is right in the heart of Auckland city, New Zealand's most populous and diverse city. Working in Auckland will give you the opportunity to work combine all the comforts of metropolitan life with the clean, green, beautiful natural landscape.
