Werribee Mercy Hospital is a publicly funded, university associated metropolitan teaching hospital. The establishment of a Neurology Service will provide the resources to address an expanding caseload and therefore meet the healthcare needs of the south-western growth corridor of metropolitan Melbourne. We are seeking experienced Consultant Neurologists to join the team at Werribee Mercy Hospital and play a key role in the establishment and the future of this service.

ABOUT THE ROLE:

This is an exciting time to join Werribee Mercy Hospital with current and future developments which will result in this hospital becoming the major tertiary public hospital in Melbourne's South West. In 2018 our services grew with the commissioning of our new multistorey acute services building, including additional Theatres, Wards and an Adult Intensive Care Unit, and in 2019 a Paediatric Ward will be established. With this expansion we will ultimately have inpatient beds providing a full suite of medical, surgical, obstetrics, gynaecology, paediatric and mental health services with an Emergency Department receiving over 40,000 presentations a year.

We have partnered with the Victorian Stroke Telemedicine (VST) program, and this role will see you building Neurology services and taking it into the future.
