Wagga Wagga Base Hospital is one of the busiest rural hospitals in NSW with 325 beds, 48,000 emergency presentations and approximately 11,000 operations annually. The hospital is in its final stages of redevelopment and supports the only non-metropolitan Neurology Advanced Trainee position in NSW. A 5 bed Acute Stroke Unit admits 400 patients annually. A stroke Nurse Practitioner and movements disorder CNC / Allied Heath team support the neurology service.

Currently, permanent onsite general Neurology and specialist stroke services are complemented by visiting subspecialist consultative services in epilepsy, neuroimmunology, neuromuscular, movement disorders and neurointervention/neurosurgery. Embedded linkage with Tertiary Neurology and Neuroradiology expertise from St Vincent's Hospital Sydney are structured with the service.

Recently or soon to be trained and fellowed Neurologists are encouraged to apply. A mixture of private and public work as a VMO can be accommodated.

18 subspecialist physicians call Wagga Wagga home, 3 or whom are senior examination panel members for the RACP clinical Exam. Two medical schools (UNSW and UNDA) provide the potential for academic or conjoint appointments.
