Apply to join the General Medical Assessment Tribunal – independent panels of medical specialists who decide complex medical questions in Queensland's workers' compensation scheme.

Tribunals are an integral part of the scheme, providing an independent medical assessment of injury or impairment for workers' compensation claims.

Current members of the tribunals describe the role as both intellectually stimulating and an opportunity for professional development through the interaction with senior practitioners in their field.
