

Neurologist - Visiting Medical Officer

Calvary Lenah Valley Hospital in conjunction with Neurosurgery Tasmania are seeking a Neurologist to be based onsite in Hobart. There is strong demand in Hobart for a private Neurologist with very limited services currently provided.

Calvary Hospital Lenah Valley is the largest private hospital in Tasmania, and is situated five minutes from the heart of the city of Hobart. The hospital provides a range of specialist services, including Neurosurgery, Orthopaedics, Maternity and Women's Health, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Colorectal Surgery and Urology. It has an Endoscopy Unit, Critical Care Unit/Intensive Care Unit with onsite registrar and a 24/7 Accident and Emergency Department on site. Calvary Lenah Valley is the state leader in robotics and technology with three active robotic programs including daVinci, ROSA and OMNIBOT as well as an AIRO intraoperative CT. Support services include an on-site pharmacy, full range of pathology services and an on-site radiology provider that offers CT, MRI and nuclear medicine imaging. Day and short stay surgery, Rehabilitation, and Oncology services are provided at the sister campus, St John's Hospital in South Hobart.

Calvary is a national Catholic provider of health, community and aged care services founded by the Sisters of the Little Company of Mary in Australia 1885. It operates in six states and territories, employs over 11,000 people and has over 1,000 volunteers. Neurosurgery Tasmania is the preeminent provider of private neurosurgery services in Tasmania, and has consultants experienced in all aspects of neurosurgery.

Particular areas of interest include Neurovascular surgery, skull base surgery, and peripheral nerve surgery. There is the potential to expand into areas of functional neurosurgery, with the appropriate neurologist support.

The Tasmanian Spine Service is a sister clinic, covering the full spectrum of spine pathologies.

It is anticipated that these clinics will provide a significant referral base for the successful neurologist.

Participation in the multidisciplinary program that currently exists within these clinics will be strongly encouraged.

Neurosurgery Tasmania will provide consulting space for a Neurologist to work as well as the referral point for all their private Neurological work. Calvary can supply an additional fully serviced consulting space in addition to this should it be required.

Calvary Lenah Valley Hospital currently have a medical on-call service throughout the year for medical admissions through the Accident and Emergency Department. Inpatients are located on a designated medical ward, which has a high observation area for acute admissions, and support by a senior medical officer during business hours. As such, Neurologists will be required to provide onsite support and consulting service rather than an on call admission service.

Support will be provided to set up in practice at Calvary Hobart and Neurosurgery Tasmania for the successful specialist.
