The positions are most suited for candidates with sub-speciality interest in one or more areas of neurology, passion for high quality care and proven commitment to teaching and/or research. Sub-speciality interest in epilepsy or headache would be highly desirable but candidates with expertise in cognitive and behavioural neurology, clinical neurophysiology, neuromuscular disorders, movement disorders, stroke and neuroimmunology would also be considered.

The successful applicant must have RACP Fellowship in Neurology but candidates nearing completion of their specialist training in neurology can also apply.
