

Royal Perth Hospital is Perth's inner city, tertiary adult teaching hospital with 450 adult beds. It is part of the East Metropolitan Health Service, and provides support to Bentley Hospital, Armadale Hospital, SJOG Midland Public Hospital, the east and west wheatbelt, Pilbara and Kimberley regions of country Western Australia, an area covering about 750,000 people.

The Neurology department provides comprehensive inpatient and outpatient neurology and clinical neurophysiology services. Subspecialty areas of expertise include advanced neurophysiological services (including ambulatory and intra-operative neurophysiology monitoring), epilepsy, neuromuscular diseases, neurogenetics, cognitive neurology, neuroimmunology and demyelinating diseases, stroke and telehealth neurology.

RPH neurology requires an AHPRA registered locum sessional neurologist from 5 Sept 2022 to 4 Feb 2023.

This is a minimum 0.7 FTE position at RPH (with potential for some increase to 1.0), and limited potential for contract extension to mid 2023. Sessions times will be within Monday-Friday 0800-1700, with approximately 1 in 6-7 weeks consultant on-call.

Remuneration is per the WA health-AMA agreement 2016. Assistance with relocation is negotiable.

General neurologists will be comfortable in the role, but expertise in neurophysiology (EEG, EMG), epilepsy and/or neuromuscular disease would be advantageous. The nature of work done will be determined by mutual agreement with the neurologist and the Neurology head of department.
