

### **Training Requirements for EMG/EEG Level 2 and 3.**

Please refer to the detailed requirements specified in the document [ANZAN Requirements for Training in Clinical Neurophysiology \(EEG/EP/EMG\)](#). Training should be undertaken in an institution with an ANZAN accredited supervisor (or equivalent if training overseas). A full time training period of 6 months is required for level 2, and 12 months for Level 3. This can be part time, so long as the training is equivalent to the full time periods.

Applicants need to provide a log book detailing all procedures performed (EMG) or reported (EEG). The log book should not include the studies required for Level 1 credentialling. Please refer to the details of the Training Requirement documents for numbers or procedures recommended. An accompanying letter detailing educational curriculum, and a letter from your supervisor is also required.

The committee strongly recommend EMG trainees sit the AANEM SAE assessment (available from your supervisor, or by joining the AANEM), and the EEG trainees sit the ASEPA-ANZAN EEG examination (application to Dr N Lawn or Dr A Bleasel).

Applications will be processed twice yearly in March and September. Applications need to be submitted the Executive staff at the ANZAN Office no later than March 10, or September 10.
