

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: DEMENTIA FELLOWSHIP

The ForeFront Research Team at the Brain & Mind Center, the University of Sydney, is calling for expressions of interest in a 12-month Dementia Fellowship commencing in January/February 2020.

The Fellow would work closely with Professors Simon Lewis and Clement Loy, as part of an NHMRC Dementia Research Team Grant. The Fellowship is intended to help develop clinical and research skills in dementia, and would suit candidates with a background or interest in Neurology or Geriatrics. The Fellow will be responsible for clinical assessment within the Dominantly Inherited Non-Alzheimer Dementias (DINAD) study. The Fellow will also be exposed to clinics caring for people with conditions including but not limited to: Alzheimer Disease, Frontotemporal Dementia, Genetic forms of dementia, and Lewy Body Dementia. There will be a full range of other research possibilities.

It is hoped that the successful candidate would build on the experience gained during this 12-month Fellowship to undertake a Higher Degree (MPhil or PhD). The Fellowship would be suitable as post-FRACP subspecialty training, an elective year, or for a Basic Physician Trainee post FRACP examinations.
