

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST: NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASE FELLOWSHIP

The Parkinson's Disease Research Clinic at the Brain & Mind Centre, University of Sydney is calling for expressions of interest in a 12 month Neurology Fellowship commencing in January/February 2018.

The position would work closely with Prof Simon Lewis as part of an NHMRC Dementia Research Team Grant. The Fellowship is intended to provide a Neurology Advanced Trainee with the development of both clinical and research expertise in the field of neurodegeneration across common conditions such as Parkinson's disease, Lewy Body Dementia, Alzheimer's, Frontotemporal Dementia and Mild Cognitive Impairment, as well as the close relationships that exist between these conditions and sleep-wake disturbance. It is hoped that this individual would want to undertake a higher degree (e.g. MPhil/PhD) and will have the opportunity to conduct research across a range of platforms including clinical trials, neuroimaging, neurogenetics, polysomnography and other biomarkers within clinical populations.
