REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITION

- FRACP or equivalent
- Unusually, this position does not require educating and teaching of students in medicine, nor does it require on-call public hospital commitments. Simply put, this is an amazing opportunity which offers normal business hours Monday to Friday, and no weekend work. Average hours will be 45 hours per week.
- You will require broad clinical experience and skills with a special interest in neurophysiology, EMG and nerve conduction studies, as we are a group of clinics specialising in neurophysiology, including for patients with work related injuries.
- You must hold Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (FRACP) or equivalent, and be eligible for registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a specialist in Neurology. If you are an International Medical Graduate and have already been assessed by the RACP as "substantially comparable" in the first instance, this will also be viewed favourably.
