



Neurology Basic Physician Trainee

The Royal Melbourne Hospital Department of Neurology is offering a 1-year unaccredited training position as a basic physician trainee (BPT) in Neurology. Trainees will have the opportunity to work closely with neurology consultants, advanced trainees, fellows and senior nursing and allied health staff. The role will provide excellent exposure and training in various aspects of neurology including hyper-acute stroke, MS/neuroimmunology, epilepsy, general neurology and others.

This clinical position is closely integrated within Neurology department activity. Trainees rotate over a 4-week roster covering days (Mon to Fri 0800-1700), afternoons (Mon to Fri 1300-2100), Nights (Mon to Sun 2030-0830), followed by a week off.

Candidates who have successfully completed the FRACP written and clinical exams will be considered. The position is an ideal springboard for Advanced Training in Neurology.
